History of Present Illness
Chief Complaints: Rheumatoid arthritis, Bilateral shoulder pain, Bilateral wrist pain, Bilateral hand pain, Bilateral knee pain and Bilateral foot pain.
Patient is a 38 year-old white male who has had 2 month(s) history of joint pain with joint swelling involving his hands, wrists, shoulders, knees and toes. This all began after a weekend fishing trip. Denies any specific trauma. Never has joint pain in the past.
Pt. went to Primary Care who ordered blood work and pt. was told he had an elevated sed rate and rheumatoid factor.
The patient's pain is continuous and rated on average a 6. Pain is rated at least a 4 and at worst a 8. Fatigue is rated as a 5. Pain is aggravated by use and relieved by rest. Morning stiffness is 2 to 4 hours. He denies fever chills, wt loss, or rash. He does admit to fatigue.
